(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025.


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Dob Lane, Little Hoole 127 metres south-east of its junction with A59 Longton Bypass for a distance of 31 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 08:00 hours on Wednesday 23rd July 2025 until 17:00 hours on Friday 25th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Dob Lane – Knoll Lane – A59 Liverpool Road – A59 Longton Bypass

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out.
