(DOB LANE, LITTLE HOOLE, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Dob Lane, Little Hoole 127 metres south-east of its junction with A59 Longton Bypass for a distance of 31 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 08:00 hours on Wednesday 23rd July 2025 until 17:00 hours on Friday 25th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Dob Lane – Knoll Lane – A59 Liverpool Road – A59 Longton Bypass

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out.
