(FOX LANE, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Fox Lane, Leyland from a point directly outside number 95 Fox Lane, Leyland.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 14:45 hours on Tuesday 1st July 2025 until 16:30 hours on Saturday 5th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out to repair a burst PE main in the carriageway.
