**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Glenside, Appley Bridge to a point of 47 meters north of its junction with Sprodley Drive for a distance of 15 meters in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1550 hours on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2025 until 1630 hours on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow repair works to a leaking service in carriageway to be carried out.
