## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(HAWARDEN AVENUE, ENDCLIFFE ROAD, MORECAMBE, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of roads;
  - I. Hawarden Avenue from its junction with South Road to its junction with Edndcliffe Road.
  - II. Endcliffe Road from its junction with Hawarden Avenue to its junction with South Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0800 hours and 1800 hours from Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025 until Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:—South Road South Avenue and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out.
