GLENSIDE, APPLEY BRIDGE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length Glenside, Appley Bridge to a point of 47 meters north of its junction with Sprodley Drive for a distance of 15 meters in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1631 hours on Monday 7th July until 1630 hours on Wednesday 9th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure will be locally signed.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent water repair works to continue.
