NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Harbour Lane, Bryning With Warton from outside number 59 for 10 metres in either direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Tuesday 8th July 2025 until 2359 hours on Friday 11th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent excavations to repair underground low voltage mains to restore loss of supply, followed by reinstatement works to be carried out Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
