(BLACK MOSS LANE, ORMSKIRK WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Black Moss Lane, Ormskirk from its junction with Redcliffe Gardens to its junction with Convent Close.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 09:30 to 15:30 hours on Friday 5th September 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
 Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Black Moss Lane, B5197 Prescot Road, Long Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow engineers to excavate and provide new ducting in footway.
