No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Back Brook Street 2-36, Walton Le Dale from approximately the northeastern boundary at the rear of property 21 Bridge Street, Walton le Dale to approximately the northwestern boundary at the rear of property 23 Bridge Street, Walton le Dale.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 08:45 hours on Wednesday 9th July 2025 until 16:30 hours on Friday 11th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to a leaking stop tap to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
