BLACKSTICKS LANE, BEACON FELL, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Blacksticks Lane, Beacon Fell from its junction with Birch Lane for approximately 40 metres in an Easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2025 until 1630 hours on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Birch Lane – Loud Bridge Back Lane – Height Lane – Parsonage Lane – Houghclough Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out.
