**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council considers it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of St James Place, Padiham from outside number 76 St James Place for a distance of 40 metres in a westerley direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Friday 11th July 2025 until 23:59 hours on Monday 14<sup>h</sup>July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation to repair a leaking stop tap on the carriageway.
