## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(FORTY ACRE LANE, LONGRIDGE, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Forty Acre Lane, Longridge from its junction with Rock Brow travelling in a south easterly direction to a point on the south side of Woodstraw Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on 26<sup>th</sup> August 2025 until 1630 hours on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Clitheroe Road – Lower Road – Lower Lane – Chapel Hill – Preston Road – Derby Road – Chipping Lane – Chipping Road – Up Bedlam Road – Rock Brow

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Morrison Telecom Services on behalf of British Telecom to carry out essential maintenance works on their assets.
