NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to:

- 1) Remove a bus stop in the following locations:
 - a) West Paddock, Leyland, the north side, from a point 8 meters east of Roberts Court;
 - b) West Paddock, Leyland, the south side, from a point 13 meters east of Roberts Court.
- 2) Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
 - a) West Paddock, Leyland, the north side, from a point 65 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Broadfield Drive for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction;
 - b) West Paddock, Leyland, the south side, from a point 116 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Woodlea Road for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The proposals are being pursued as part of a Section 278 agreement under the Highways Act 1980 under the Town and Country Planning Act as part of a new development linked to 72 age restricted apartments including a cafe bistro and a small retail unit (open to the public) and the associated planning conditions Which will result in more vulnerable residents with a higher dependency of public transport. The purpose of the proposal is to relocate two existing bus stops to remove them from the frontage of dwellings and allow for the upgrade to two new quality provision bus stops with clearways. The proposed Bus Stop Clearways will allow the buses to pull in and out safely and allow for effective enforcement. A raised boarding platform will also be installed to ensure safe boarding and alighting of passengers.
