- 1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (South Ribble Borough Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to:
 - a) Item (218) of Schedule 10.01;
 - b) Item (23) of Schedule 11.075.
- 2. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in West Paddock, Leyland, both sides, from its junction with the Centreline of Broadfield Drive/Woodlea Road for a distance of 22.5 meters in a westerly direction.
- 3. Introduce a restriction of waiting Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm in West Paddock, Leyland, both sides, from a point 22.5 meters west of its junction with the Centreline of Broadfield Drive/Woodlea Road for a distance of 359.5 meters in a westerly direction.
