NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear Hyndburn Street, Accrington from number 46 for a distance of 17 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1210 hours on Sunday 20th July 2025 until 2359 hours on Thursday 24th July 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation to replace leaking water service works to be carried out by United Utilities on behalf of Network Plus.
