## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(RAILWAY STREET, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time or wait at any time for the purposes of Loading or Unloading on any day, except buses providing a scheduled service on the following length of Railway Street, Nelson from its junction with Bradshaw Street to its junction with Netherfield Road.
- 2. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025 until 1600 hours on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Nothing in this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred in article 1 for so long as may be necessary to enable:
  - i. a person to board or alight from the vehicle.
  - ii. the vehicle to be used for the purposes of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road; the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
  - iii. A Royal Mail Liveried vehicle engaged in the collection and/or delivery of letters in accordance with the statutory provisions as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the temporary suspension of the existing loading bay on Railway Street to ease traffic flow for buses using a diversion route.
