(BILSBORROW LANE, BILSBORROW, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bilsborrow Lane, Bilsborrow from its junction with Garstang Road to its junction with Church Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 28th July 2025 until 1730 hours on Sunday 3rd August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Garstang Road – New Lane – Ducketts Lane – Lydaite Lane – Bilsborrow Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the construct a new manhole on the existing UU sewer for the new development of 4 houses to be carried out.
