(DELPH LANE, BARNACRE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Delph Lane, Barnacre from its junction with Keepers Lane to its junction with Hazelhead Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Thursday 28th August 2025 until 1630 hours on Friday 29th August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Hazelhead Lane – Gubberford Lane – Lancaster New Road – Lancaster Road – High Street – Bridge Street – Bonds Lane – Garstang Road – New Lane – Lodge Road – Smithy Lane - Sandholme Lane – Turners Lane – Barnacre Lodge Drive and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out.
