(GRANGE ROAD, SINGLETON, FYLDE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Grange Road, Singleton from its junction with Larbreck Road for approximately 55 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2100 hours on Tuesday 26th August 2025 until 0600 hours on Wednesday 27th August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Church Road – The Village – Mile Road – Larbreck Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow cable renewal works to be carried out.
