(BANNISTER LANE, FARINGTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Bannister Lane, Leyland from a point 300 metres west of its junction with Croston Road to its end.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1000 hours on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> July 2025 until 2359 hours on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by this closure will not be available.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to ensure safety of the public.
