(DAMSIDE STREET, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.


- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Damside Street, Lancaster from its junction with New Road to its junction with Wood Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2000 hours on Monday 1st September 2025 until 0500 hours on Tuesday 2nd September 2025 or until completion of the works within this period
- 4. Access for Emergency Service Vehicles will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is one way via:-

A6 China Street – A6 North Road – A6 Rosemary Lane – A6 Stonewell – A6 Great John Street – A6 Dalton Square – A6 Thurnham Street – A6 Penny Street – A6 King Street – A6 China Street.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to enable safe access to Manholes in the carriageway for engineers for survey to be carried out by Global Surveys.
