TOWN LANE, HESKIN, CHORLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Town Lane, Heskin from its junction with Barmskin Lane to its junction with the B5250 Wood Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 8th September 2025 until 1700 hours on Friday 12th September or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Barmskin Lane - Church Lane - B5250 Wood Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Excavation of a joint bay to install cable for new 1ph supply works to be carried out.
