

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(STAYNALL LANE, STALMINE-WITH-STAYNALL, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Staynall Lane, Stalmine-With-Staynall from its junction with Wardleys Lane to its junction with junction with Burrows Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1700 hours on Monday 1st September 2025 until Friday 5th September 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Burrows Lane – High Lane – Back Lane – Cemetery Lane – Hall Gate Lane – Mill Lane – Stricklands Lane – Carr Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the installation of joint cable for new connection for car charging point located on private lane to be carried out.
