NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any pedestrian to proceed over that length of footway on Lord Street, Preston from its junction with Lancaster Road to its junction with Tithebarn Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0730 hours on Thursday 14th August 2025 until 1700 hours on Thursday 28th August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for pedestrians affected by the closure is via:-

Tithebarn Street – Old Vicarage – Lancaster Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow sewer works to be carried out.
