EAVES LANE, RAPLEY LANE AND CUDDY HILL, CATFORTH, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Eaves Lane, Rapley Lane and Cuddy Hill, Catforth from its junction with Brierley Lane to its junction with Cinder Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 18th August 2025 until 1630 hours on Wednesday 20th August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Moorside Lane – Newsham Hall Lane – Woodplumpton Lane – Whittingham Lane - James Towers Way - Garstang Road – Station Lane – Eaves Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out.
