(TAYLORS LANE, PILLING, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Taylors Lane, Pilling from its junction with Backsands Lane to outside Broadfleet Cottage.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 26th August 2025 until 1700 hours on Thursday 28th August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
School Lane – Smallwood Hey Road – Carr Lane – A588 Lancaster Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation to install new water connection works to be carried out Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
