**MOSELEY ROAD AND HUFLING LANE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH.  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Moseley Road and Hufling Lane, Burnley from 20 metres either side of the Level Crossing.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2330 hours on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2025 until 0830 hours on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for motor vehicles will be maintained whenever and wherever possible and for pedestrians at all times.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:  
Moseley Road – Woodlumpston Road – Hufling Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow rail corrosion inspection works to be carried out by Network Rail.
