
(WOODMAN LANE, COWAN BRIDGE, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (No.2) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Wooman Lane, Cowan Bridge from its junction with A683 Burrow Road to A65 Long Level.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Monday 22nd September 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
A683 Burrow Road – A65 Long Level and Vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecoms pole maintenance works to be carried out on behalf of Openreach.
