- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Clayton Gate, Coppull from its junction with Chapel Lane, Coppull to its junction with Spendmore Lane and The Chestnuts, Coppull.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 11:15 hours on Wednesday 13th August 2025 until 16:30 hours on Sunday 17th August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency carriageway repair works to be carried out.
