NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Scriffen Lane, Ellel from the entrance to Smith Green Depot to a point adjacent to The Garage.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Friday 22nd August 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents & emergency Services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:Scriffen Lane Bay Horse Road Five Lane Ends Stoney Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safety of engineer to work on overhead structure for pole test to be carried out on behalf of Openreach.
