
NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ST ANNES ROAD WEST, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH)
(ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 07 August 2025 and 04 September 2025, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

Introduce one way traffic in St Annes Road West, Lytham St Annes, from its junction with Clifton Drive South to its junction with North Promenade/South Promenade north east to south west.



Statement of Reasons

During the formal consultation period starting on the 7th August 2025, it was noted that the direction of the intended traffic flow was erroneously advertised as running from south west to north east (The Promenade towards Clifton Drive North). The purpose of this proposal is to correct the direction of the intended traffic flow.
