(GARSTANG ROAD, PILING, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Garstang Road, Piling from its junction with Carr Bridge Road to its junction with Bone Hill Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours until 1530 hours on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
A588 Lancaster Road - A588 Sandside - A588 Marsh Lane - B5272 Main Street - B5272 Garstang Road - B5272 Park Lane - B5272 Cockerham Road - A6 Garstang Bypass Road - Longmoor Lane - Kilcrash Lane - Cartmell Lane – Black Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out by Openreach.
