(GARSTANG ROAD, PILING, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Garstang Road, Piling from its junction with Carr Bridge Road to its junction with Bone Hill Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours until 1530 hours on Thursday 23rd October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-A588 Lancaster Road - A588 Sandside - A588 Marsh Lane - B5272 Main Street - B5272 Garstang Road - B5272 Park Lane - B5272 Cockerham Road - A6 Garstang Bypass Road - Longmoor Lane -Kilcrash Lane - Cartmell Lane - Black Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole testing works to be carried out by Openreach.
