(HIGH MOOR LANE, WRIGHTINGTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of High Moor Lane, Wrightington from its junction with Stoney Lane to its junction with Robin Hood Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Thursday 13th November until 1500 hours on Friday 14th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Robin Hood Lane, A5209 Sparrow Lane, B5246 Lancaster Lane, B5246 Chorley Road, Bannister Lane, Whittle Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole maintenance works to be carried out.
