(STATION ROAD, HOGHTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Station Road, Hoghton from a point 20 metres either side of the Hoghton Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2300 hours on Saturday 15th November 2025 until 0700 hours on Sunday 16th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Station Road, Hoghton – A675 Hoghton Lane - Station Road, Hoghton.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent inspection works to be carried out.
