(WILLOW HEY & WINDROWS SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any cycle or pedestrian to proceed over the following length of highway:
 - a. F800 Willow Hey, Skelmersdale from outside number 8 Willow Hey for a distance of 59 metres to the rear of number 2 Willow Hey.
 - b. F800 Windrows, Skelmersdale to be closed in its entirety from a point 5 metres south of its boundary with U5225 Windrows to its most southern boundary of its footways.
 - c. U5225 Windrows, Skelmersdale (south footway only) from its most eastern boundary with property number 1 for a distance of 80 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 20th October until 1700 hours on Friday 14th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for pedestrians affected by the closure will be signposted locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out.
