(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of road:
 - Bentley Lane, Heskin from its junction with Barmskin Lane to its merging with Bentley Lane, Mawdesley.
 - Bentley Lane, Mawdesley from its merging with Bentley Lane, Heskin for a distance of 255 metres in a westerly direction
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Thursday 9th October 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 12th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Bentley Lane, Mawdesley – Jacksons Lane - Bannister Lane – Whittle Lane – High Moor Lane – Robin Hood Lane - Hill House Fold Lane - Courage Low Lane – Toogood Lane – Smithy Brow – Barmskin Lane – Bentley Lane, Heskin and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation, and reinforcement works to be carried out to accommodate LV supply.
