(WALTON STREET, COLNE, PENDLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Walton Street, Colne from its junction with Church Street to its junction with Walton Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours until 1900 hours on Sunday 14th September 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Market Street - Skipton Road - North Valley Road - Vivary Way - Whitehalls Drive - Burnley Road - Primet Hill - Albert Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Openreach on behalf of British Telecom to carry out repair works on a Manhole frame and cover.
