REAR 55 TO 73 BURNLEY ROAD AND COWLEY CRESCENT,
PADIHAM, BURNLEY BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause motor vehicle or pedestrian to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Burnley:
 - i. Cowley Crescent, Padiham from its junction with Scott Street for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction.
 - ii Rear 55 to 73 Burnley Road, Padiham from rear of house numbers 53 to 55 – pedestrian diversion to follow Scott Street
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours on Monday 20th October 2025 to 1700 hours on Monday 27th October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services is to always be maintained.**
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:
Cowley Crescent – Cowley Street – Padiham Road – Scott Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavate joint bay and install new underground link box to be carried out by Network Plus.
