(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rawcliffe Road, Out Rawcliffe from its junction with Hagg Lane to outside Meadowcroft.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 27th October 2025 until 1630 hours on Tuesday 28th October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Lancaster Road - Skitham Lane - Longmoor Lane - A6 Preston Lancaster New Road - The Avenue - A586 Tarnacre Lane - Garstang Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom upgrade works to be carried out by BT.
