(RAWCLIFFE ROAD, OUT RAWCLIFFE, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rawcliffe Road, Out Rawcliffe from its junction with Hagg Lane to outside Meadowcroft.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 27th October 2025 until 1630 hours on Tuesday 28th October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Lancaster Road - Skitham Lane - Longmoor Lane - A6 Preston
Lancaster New Road - The Avenue - A586 Tarnacre Lane - Garstang Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom upgrade works to be carried out by BT.
