(PRESTON ROAD, LONGRIDGE, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Preston Road, Longridge from its junction with Chapel Hill travelling in a northerly direction to a point on the north side of number 62.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on until 1500 hours on 5th October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Kestor Lane - Dilworth Lane - Lower Lane - Chapel Hill

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities to replace a manhole frame and cover in the carriageway.
