(WESLEY STREET AND STUBBINS LANE, SABDEN, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Wesley Street and Stubbins Lane, Sabden as follows: -
 - **Wesley Street** from a point outside number 12 Wesley Street to its junction with Stubbins Lane.
 - Stubbins lane from a point outside 16 Stubbins Lane to a point at the side of 52 Wesley Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 13th October 2025 until 1700 hours on 5th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
 - Wesley Street Stubbins Lane St Nicholas Avenue Padiham Road
 - Stubbins Lane Wesley Street Padiham Road St Nicholas Avenue

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Cadent Gas to carry out gas mains replacement works.
