## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(HIGHER ROAD, LONGRIDGE, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Higher Road, Longridge from a point outside Cowley Brook Cottage travelling in a westerly direction for approximately 76 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2025 until 1700 hours on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained when following the diversion route. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Stoneygate Lane - Clitheroe Road - Lower Road - Lower Lane - Dilworth Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities to carry out the installation of a new customer connection.
