(HIGHER ROAD, LONGRIDGE, RIBBLE VALLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025


**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Higher Road, Longridge from a point outside Cowley Brook Cottage travelling in a westerly direction for approximately 76 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2025 until 1700 hours on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents and emergency services will be maintained when following the diversion route. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Stoneygate Lane – Clitheroe Road – Lower Road – Lower Lane - Dilworth Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities to carry out the installation of a new customer connection.
