## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BACK LANE, OUT RAWCLIFFE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Lane, Out Rawcliffe from outside Buck's Farm for 10 metres in either direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> November 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Whin Lane - Mill Lane - Bull Park Lane - A588 Shard Lane - A588 Green Meadow Lane - A588 Carr Lane - A588 Stricklands Lane - Moss Side Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation of a new water connection work to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilites.
