## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BLACK LANE, NATEBY, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Black Lane, Nateby from outside Fowlers Farm for 100 metres in a north easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2025 until 1630 hours on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: Cartmell Lane Kilcrash Lane Longmoor Lane Preston Lancaster
   New Road B5272 (Cockerham Road) Park Lane Broad Lane Church Lane Island Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation of new telegraph pole works to be carried out by Morrisons Telecom Services on behalf of BT.
