(HAZELHEAD LANE, BARNACRE, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hazelhead Lane, Barnacre from its junction with Gubberford Lane to outside to Woodacre Hall Farm.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Thursday 6th November 2025 until 1630 hours on Tuesday 11th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Gubberford Lane - The Barn Lane - Higher Lane - Keepers Lane - Delph Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation of 8 wooden poles for fibre works to be carried out by Morrisons Telecom Services on behalf of BT.
