(HAZELHEAD LANE, BARNACRE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hazelhead Lane, Barnacre from its junction with Gubberford Lane to outside to Woodacre Hall Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Thursday 6th November 2025 until 1630 hours on Tuesday 11th November 2025 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Gubberford Lane - The Barn Lane - Higher Lane - Keepers Lane -Delph Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation of 8 wooden poles for fibre works to be carried out by Morrisons Telecom Services on behalf of BT.
