
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 65(1) AND 66(4) (TULKETH BROW, PRESTON, PRESTON) (REMOVAL OF CYCLE LANE)



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 65(1) and 66(4) of the Highways Act 1980 Lancashire County Council propose to remove a cycle lane in Tulketh Brow, Preston, the south-west side, from its junction with Waterloo Road to its junction with Water Lane in a south easterly direction.



## Statement of Reasons

This proposal forms part of a wider package of highway improvements designed to enhance traffic flow, road safety, and active travel infrastructure. Creating or enhancing shared-use paths to promote walking and cycling. These interventions will enhance the safe and efficient movement of all road users. It is hoped that these proposals will support and encourage sustainable modes of transport, in line with both local and national transport policy objectives. The proposal includes the removal of cycleway, reconfiguring road layouts to reduce congestion and improve junction efficiency.
